Buckfast

Selected in Germany, known for its exceptional combination of qualities. It is extremely docile and easy to manage. Very prolific and hardworking, with high honey production. Low tendency to swarm. Disease resistance: it is the result of selective breeding for hardiness and resistance to parasites such as varroa. These qualities make it a very efficient and manageable breed.



Buckfast-VSH

Combines the qualities of the original Buckfast with specific genetic resistance to varroa. VSH bees identify and eliminate infested pupae, reducing the mite population. Intrinsic resistance reduces reliance on anti-varroa treatments. Fewer mites mean stronger and more productive colonies. Maintains the renowned manageability and performance characteristics of the Buckfast. Ideal for beekeepers seeking a robust bee with simplified integrated pest management.



Italian

Selected in Finland for over thirty years. Great docility, which makes it easy to manage. Very well adapted to harsh winters. High honey productivity and development of strong colonies. Good disease resistance. It is considered one of the best commercial bees, appreciated globally for its reliability in beekeeping.



Carniolan

Highly prized in beekeeping for its remarkable docility. Extremely hardworking and productive in the collection of honey and pollen. Great resilience and excellent overwintering ability: it effectively manages reserves and reduces brood size depending on the harvest. It is also particularly well-suited to harsh climates and rapid weather changes.



Caucasian

Remarkable docility and high honey productivity. Reduced tendency to swarm. Adaptability to different climates. Development of strong colonies. Effective nectar collection, even from plants with deep-calyx flowers, thanks to its particularly long ligule (blueberry, subalpine lupin, clover, sunflower, borage). It is a reliable breed for beekeepers seeking manageable and productive bees.



Carniolan x Caucasian

Combines the parental qualities, taking advantage of hybrid vigor. Exceptional docility from both breeds. High honey production. Reduced tendency to swarm (Caucasian heritage, unlike the pure Carnica, which swarms more). Adaptability to diverse climates, from mountainous to milder regions. Ability to collect nectar from deep-calyx flowers (the Caucasian's long tongue). It offers a balanced combination of manageability, productivity, and resilience.



Elgon

The Buckfast-Monticola hybrid offers a combination of desirable traits: extremely docility, strong hygienic behavior (essential for resistance to diseases and parasites such as Varroa), reduced tendency to swarm, allowing colonies to remain strong and productive. Good honey production. It is an excellent choice for beekeepers seeking a robust, manageable bee that is naturally resistant to health challenges.
